WHEREAS, Mr. Edwin E. Lovelace, District Engineer, concurs with the Payson City request of transfer and indicates that there is already special authority approved for the resurfacing and lighting of the subject highway.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the Authority of Sec. 27-12-27, UCA, 1953, as amended is hereby resolved as follows:

1. That State Route 234 in its entirety be deleted from the State System of Highways.

 That this action becomes effective upon the completion of the following improvements on the subject highway:

- 1- Installation of Street lighting from U.S. 91 South to 800 South, thence West to U.S. 91 - (Under a street lighting agreement).
- 2- Resurfacing (Main Street from U.S. 91 South to 800 South, thence West to U.S. 91).
- 3- Make improvements (Change at intersection 800 South and Main).

3. That by this action State Highway System mileage will decrease 1.1 + - miles and Payson City "C" mileage will increase 1.1 + - miles.

4. That the letter from the Payson City Corporation relating their desires concerning the aforementioned transfer of State Route 234, is hereby


