1963 Description:

From a connection with FAI-15 easterly via 6th South Street to 1st West Street in Salt Lake City providing one way eastbound traffic and from another connection with FAI-15 easterly via 5th South Street in Salt Lake City to Route 176 providing one way westbound traffic. This route was approved by the **Legislature**.

1965 Description:

From Route 1 (Interstate 15) easterly via 6th South Street 1st West Street in Salt Lake City, providing one-way eastbound traffic; and from another connection with Route 1 (Interstate 15) easterly via 5th South Street in Salt Lake City to Route 176 providing one-way westbound traffic.

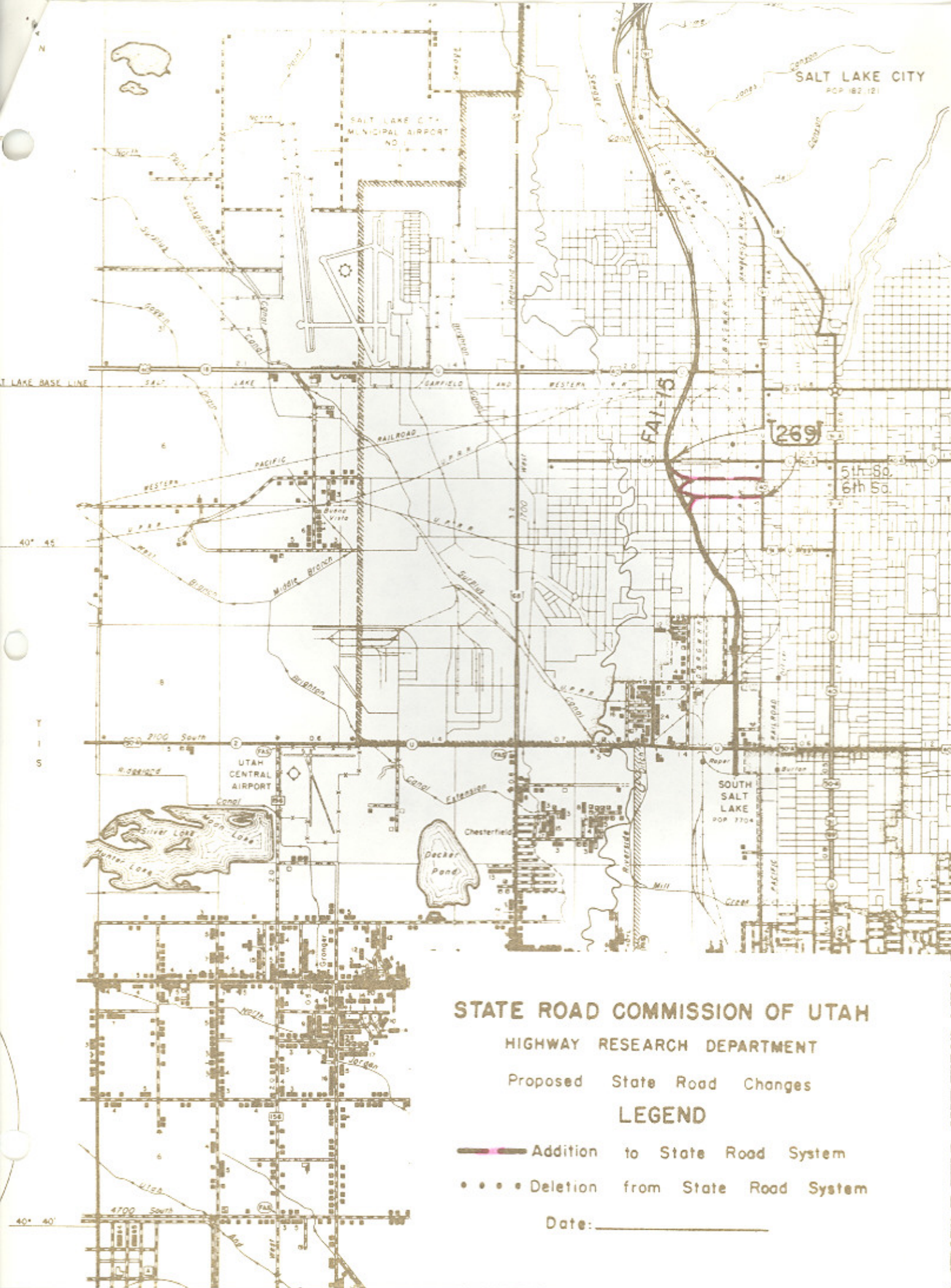
