

RESOLUTION

Deletion of State Highway SR-297 Salt Lake County

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 66 of the 1999 General Session of the Utah State Legislature amended provisions for the designation of state highways in section 72 of the Utah State Code 1998, and

WHEREAS, The Utah Department of Transportation has not maintained the roadways traversing inside the confines of the Utah State Fair Park for a considerable measure of time, nor has the Utah State Fair Park authorities asked the department to do so, and

WHEREAS, the Utah State Fair Park authorities have full use and control of the roadways and these roadways described herein are subject to change and alteration of alignment as seen appropriate by the authorities of the Utah State Fair Park, also the roadways described herein fail to meet the criteria established in section 72-4-102.5 for state highways, and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Utah State Fair Grounds has requested the Utah Department of Transportation through the actions of the Transportation Commission transfer the roadways described herein to the legal control of the Utah State Fair Park authorities, and

WHEREAS, The Region Two Director, along with the appropriate staff of the Program Development Division, reviewing the criteria for state highways and the request of the Executive Director of the Utah State Fair Park concur the roadways residing within the confines of the Utah State Fair Park should be legally transferred to the jurisdiction of the Utah State Fair Park authorities.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

- SR-297 in its entirety legally described as follows and depicted in Exhibit "A", be deleted from the state highway system and be placed under the jurisdiction of the Utah State Fair Park authorities a distance of 1.25± miles.
 - (a) The roadway beginning at the main gate of the Fair Grounds at 1st North Street and 9st West Street in Salt Lake City, west to the roadway on the east side of the Coliseum; then south to the roadway on the north side of the Coliseum; then west to the roadway on the west side of the Coliseum; then south to the roadway on the north side of the cattle barns; then east to the horticulture building; then north to the roadway on the south side of the drivers' license building; then east to the roadway on the east side of the drivers' license building; then north to the roadway near the main gate, providing a peripheral road around the fair grounds area.

- (b) The roadway from the peripheral road on the south, north to the peripheral road on the north.
- (c) The roadway from the peripheral road on the west, east on the south side of the Coliseum to Route 297-b.
- (d) The roadway from Route 297-c north on the east side of the Coliseum to the peripheral road.
- (e) The roadway from Route 297-d near the main entrance to the Coliseum, east to Route 297-b.
- (f) The roadway from Route 297-b east to the peripheral road near the southwest corner of the drivers' license building.
- (g) The roadway, including the parking area, on the west side of the drivers' license building, from Route 297-f north to the peripheral road.
- By this action the Utah Department of Transportation abandons any and all interest of aforementioned roadways within the Utah State Fair Park facility.
- 3. Since the afore-mentioned roadways will no longer serve as a public roadways the functional classification of local will be dropped and these roads will not be eligible for class "C" road funding.
- This deletion and transfer will become effective upon passage by the Utah Transportation Commission.
- 5. The accompanying Letter, Memo and Exhibit "A" be made part of this resolution.
