RESOLUTION

State Route 306 d 217

WHEREAS, Section 63-11-20, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended, relates that: "All roads connecting state parks with federal, state or county highways or city streets where the title thereto is in the state are parts of the state highway system and are to be maintained by the state. The road commission is authorized to construct and maintain roads within state parks subject to approval of locations and design by the commission through its director", and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Utah State Road Commission and the Utah State Division of Parks and Recreation to define responsibility for the administration of roads at state parks, and

WHEREAS, it is agreed between the State Road Commission and the State Division of Parks and Recreation that certain roads meet the criteria set forth in Section 63-11-20, 1953, as amended, and

WHEREAS, those roads at state parks that are part of the State System of Highways should be identified by a number.

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with Section 63-11-20, UCA, 1953, as amended, it is hereby resolved as follows:

That the roadway from the parking area north to State Route 66 near the north end of East Canyon Lake State Park, a distance of 0.15 + - mile, be identified as State Route 306,

That the letter from the Morgan County Commission relating their concurrence in this action be hereby incorporated as a part of this submission,

That the maps attached illustrating the action taken herewith and the location of East Canyon Lake State Park be hereby incorporated as a part of this submission.

Subject: Roads at State Parks

Dear Chairman Wilkinson:

The State Division of Parks and Recreation and the State Highway Department have discussed proposals for the construction and maintenance of roads at State Parks. At a number of parks existing roads require maintenance and in some cases new construction is needed. The two State agencies have come to an agreement upon a course of action at a State Park situated within your county.

It has been proposed that a connection from SR-66 at East Canyon State Park to the marina in the park be designated as State Road 306 and that the State Highway Department assume maintenance and construction responsibilities for this short stub road.

I am enclosing a copy of a resolution which will be presented to the State Road Commission for adoption if the proposed action is acceptable to your Board of Commissioners. I would appreciate a letter from your Board stating its position on the proposal set forth in the draft resolution.
