State Route 307



WHEREAS, Section 63-11-20, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, as amended, relates that: "All roads connecting state parks with federal, state or county highways or city streets where the title thereto is in the state are parts of the state highway system and are to be maintained by the state. The state road commission is authorized to construct and maintain roads within state parks subject to approval of locations and design by the commission through its director", and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Utah State Road Commission and the Utah State Division of Parks and Recreation to define responsibility for the administration of roads at state parks, and

WHEREAS, it is agreed between the State Road Commission and the State Division of Parks and Recreation that certain roads meet the criteria set forth in Section 63-11-20, UCA, 1953, as amended, and

WHEREAS, those roads at state parks that are part of the State System of Highways should be identified by a number.

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with Section 63-11-20, UCA, 1953, as amended, it is hereby resolved as follows:

That the roadway from the parking area at Gunlock Lake State Park east to Federal-aid Secondary Route 416, State Collector Road 7, a distance of 0.15 + mile, be identified as State Route 307,

That the maps attached illustrating the action taken herewith and the location of Gunlock Lake State Park be hereby incorporated as a part of this submission. Dated this 7. STX day of____





R E S O L U T I O N Addition of State Route 219 Deletion of State Route 307

WHEREAS, the City Officials of Enterprise and the County Officials of Washington County have expressed their desire to delete State Route 307 at Gunlock Lake State Beach as a trade for the addition of Main Street in Enterprise to the State System of Highways, and

WHEREAS, the addition of Main Street in Enterprise would be from Enterprise's present west incorporate boundary, east to a junction with State Route 18, a distance of 1.3 miles,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

That the Transportation Commission recommend to the next Legislature that in accordance with Section 27-12-28 of the Utah Code Annotated, 1953, State Route 307 (0.22 miles) be deleted in its entirety and that Main Street in the Town of Enterprise, from its present west incorporate boundary east 1.3 miles to a junction with State Route 18 be added to the State System of Highways, and be designated as Route 219,

That by this action, State Highway System mileage will increase 1.08 miles,

That the accompanying maps be hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.




