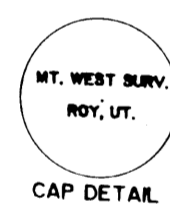

NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO RE-ESTABLISH THE EAST LINE OF COUNTRYBROOK SUBDIVISION, UNIT 1. MONUMENTATION FOUND WITHIN THE SUBDIVISION WAS UTILIZED FOR CONTROL AND THE SECTION MONUMENTS WERE USED AS THE BASIS OF BEARING. WITH THE CONVERSION TO UTAH STATE PLANE GRID SHOWN, NO APPARENT CONFLICTS WERE OBSERVED ON THE GROUND.
