## BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION

All of Lot 20, Fairfield Acres Subdivision Plat I, according to the official plat thereof on record in the Weber County Recorder's Office, Book 12, Page 72.

## NARRATIVE

This survey was requested by Mr. Marc Hansen for the purpose of re-establishing property corners. Brass Cap Monuments were found at the North Quarter Corner and the Northwest Corner of Section 29, T7N, R1W, SLB&M, U.S. Survey. A line bearing North 89°39'58" West between these monuments was used as the Basis of Bearings. The subdivision was placed on the ground using the existing occupation by splitting the curb lines on 100 East Street to determine the East-West position of the subdivision. The platted subdivision section corner ties do not fit the existing occupation on the ground. The Northwest corner of Section 29 was set after the original subdivision was platted and constructed. The relationship between the North 1/4 corner and the Northwest corner of Section 29, has been shown on this survey. Weber County bearings were used and then rotated to match the platted subdivision information. Property Corners were monumented as shown.
