





SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE:

I, DEVRON ANDERSEN, A PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR HOLDING LICENSE NUMBER 7897281, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF UTAH, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 58, CHAPTER 22, PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR'S LICENSING ACT, HAVE COMPLETED A SURVEY OF THE HIGHWAY CENTERLINE DESCRIBED HEREON IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 17-23-17 AND HAVE VERIFIED ALL MEASUREMENTS AND PLACED MONUMENTS OF THE GROUND AS REPRESENTED HEREON.



I, BAHICAM RAHIMZAGEGAFLS, DO HEREBY CERTIFY THAT I AM A DEPUTY SURVEYOR OF THE WEBE COUNTY RECORDER/SURVEYOR'S OFFICE, STATE OF UTAH, AS PRESCRIBED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF UTAH AND THAT A SURVEY OF THE HIGHWAY CENTERLINE HAS BEEN MADE UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE WEBER COUNTY RECORDER/SURVEYOR AS SHOWN AND DESCRIBED HEREOLD



SURVEYOR'S NARRATIVE:

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO DETERMINE THE TRUE LOCATION OF THE EXISTING HIGHWAY CENTERLINE OF 2900 EAST AND 3350 NORTH. THE BASIS OF BEARING FOR THIS SURVEY IS SOUTH 00° 09' 25" EAST (STATE PLANE GRID BEARINGS) 5,337.22 FEET, AS MEASURED BETWEEN WEBER COUNTY BRASS CAP MONUMENTS 7N1E20N AND 7N1E29N AS SHOWN HEREON. EXISTING FENCES, EXISTING ASPHALT ROAD, AND FOUND REBAR WITHIN ADJOINING SUBDIVISIONS WERE USED AS THE BEST EVIDENCE FOR ESTABLISHING THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD. A BEST FIT LINE BETWEEN FENCES WAS AVERAGED ALONG WITH BEST FIT LINES FROM ADJOINING SUBDIVISIONS, DEEDS, AND RECORDS OF SURVEY TO DETERMINE THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD.

TOGETHER NEARLY PERFECTLY AS A NORTH OR SOUTH BLOCK, AND ARE CLEARLY MEANT TO CONVEY TITLE TO THE EXISTING LOCATION OF THE HIGHWAY AT THE TIME. SOME EXAMPLE EXCERPTS FROM THESE DEEDS ARE, "...BEING A PART OF SPRING CREEK ROAD...BEGINNING AT INTERSECTION OF THI CENTERLINE...ALONG WEST FENCE LINE OF SPRING CREEK ROAD...ETC..." (FROM DEED BOOK 137 PAGE 169), AND "...BEING A PART OF SPRING CREEK ROAD...WHICH IS IN THE EXISTING ROAD...ETC..." (FROM DEED BOOK 137 PAGE 171). THIS TYPE OF LANGUAGE IS COMMON TO A MAJORITY OF THE 1940-1942 DESCRIPTIONS. IT IS CLEAR THAT THE TITLE TO THE HIGHWAY IN THE AREAS NORTH AND SOUTH OF THE 1925 BREAK AREA ARE THEMSELVES NEARLY CONTIGUOUS. ALTHOUGH THE OVERALL BLOCKS OF NORTH AND SOUTH DESCRIPTIONS FIT WELL TOGETHER, THEIR FIT TO THE PHYSICAL HIGHWAY AS A WHOLE IS ABOUT AS GOOD AS THE FIT OF THE ADJOINING DEEDS. AS SHOWN HEREON, THE DEEDS HAVE BEEN DRAFTED TO SHOW THESE CONTIGUOUS NORTH / SOUTH BLOCKS, ROTATED AND TRANSLATED TO BEST HONOR THE FENCES CALLED FOR IN THE DEEDS, AND OTHERWISE LEFT AS RECORD. BECAUSE THE LANGUAGE OF THE DEEDS IS INTERPRETED AS IF TO CONVEY THE EXISTING HIGHWAY, AND BECAUSE NO EVIDENCE CAN BE FOUND TO SHOW THE EXISTING ROAD IN ANY LOCATION OTHER THAN WHERE IT IS TODAY, CLEAR TITLE SHOULD BELONG TO THE PRESENT LOCATION OF THE HIGHWAY. THE TOPOGRAPHY OF THE AREA IS SUCH THAT 2900 EAST BEGINS A STEEP CLIMB AS IT PROGRESSES SOUTHERLY TOWARDS 3350 NORTH AND IS MOST EVIDENT IN THE CURVE AT THE SOUTHERLY END OF 2900 EAST. IF THE ROAD HAD EVER EXISTED IN A DIFFERENT LOCATION OTHER THAN WHERE IT IS NOW, FILL MATERIAL FOR A DIFFERENT ROAD WOULD STILL REMAIN. NO SUCH EVIDENCE COULD BE FOUND. INTERPRETING THE DEEDS AS CONVEYING CLEAR TITLE TO THE NOW EXISTING HIGHWAY ALSO PRESERVES THE HARMONY OF THE HIGHWAY IN RELATION TO ADJOINING LANDOWNERS. PAROLE EVIDENCE WAS GATHERED BY SPEAKING WITH SEVERAL LANDOWNERS. ALL OF WHICH ACKNOWLEDGED THAT THERE WERE PROBLEMS WITH HOW THEIR DEEDS WERE DESCRIBED BUT ALL OF WHICH ALSO TESTIFIED THAT THE EXISTING ROAD AND FENCE LINES ALONG THE HIGHWAY HAVE BEEN IN THE SAME LOCATIONS AS FAR BACK AS THEY COULD REMEMBER. TWO PARTICULAR LANDOWNERS (MR. FINDER OF PARCEL #22-009-0091 AND MR. SHUPE OF PARCEL #22-009-0022) BOTH TESTIFIED THAT NOTHING HAD CHANGED REGARDING THE ROAD OR FENCE LINES FOR GREATER THAN 40 YEARS.



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

THENCE SOUTH 83° 16' 53" EAST A DISTANCE OF 2,661.69 FEET TO THE INTERSECTION OF 3350 NORTH AND 3500 EAST AT STATION 90+03.05. THE BEARING AND DISTANCE FROM THIS POINT TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING BEING NORTH 35° 53' 54" WEST A DISTANCE OF 6,722.70 FEET, ALSO THE BEARING AND DISTANCE FROM SAID POINT TO THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 29 OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED TOWNSHIP AND RANGE BEING NORTH 01° 37' 25" EAST A DISTANCE OF 1,464.72 FEET, ALSO THE BEARING AND DISTANCE FROM SAID POINT TO THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 29 OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED TOWNSHIP AND RANGE BEING SOUTH 00° 04' 25" EAST A DISTANCE OF 3,776.86 FEET. THE TOTAL COMBINED LENGTH OF THE TWO ABOVE DESCRIBED ROADS BEING 9.003.05

SURVEYOR'S NARRATIVE CONTINUED FROM PAGE 1:

BETWEEN THE NORTH AND SOUTH GROUPS PREVIOUSLY MENTIONED. IN THIS AREA, TITLE TO A PARCEL ACQUIRED IN 1925 (DEED BOOK 103 PAGE 473) USES A DESCRIPTION WHICH ON THE EAST SIDE MATCHED "...EXCLUSIVE OF THAT PART OF THE PRESENT COUNTY ROAD..." TO MEAN "RESTRICTED OR LIMITED TO" FURTHER EVIDENCED WHEN COMPARING THE AREA DESCRIBED BY METES (0.568 ACRES CALCULATED) TO THE AREA SAID TO BE BOUND BY THE ROAD (0.447 ACRE). THIS INDICATES THAT THE ROADWAY ITSELF WAS

"WEDGE" AND ANY OVERLAP IN DESCRIPTION MUST BE CONSTRAINED BY PREVIOUS TITLE HELD BY ITS ADJOINERS. LANGUAGE SUCH AS, "...ALONG THE WEST LINE OF THE ROAD..." AND "...BOTH OF SAID TRACTS ARE A PART OF SPRING CREEK ROAD." LIMIT THIS DESCRIPTION TO AREAS CONTAINED IN THE PRESENT

AVAILABLE DESCRIPTIONS DO NOT COMPLETELY ACCOUNT FOR ALL OF THE HIGHWAY AND 3 GAPS IN PUBLICLY OWNED TITLE AREAS HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED. THE FIRST GAP OCCURS BETWEEN THE NORTHERLY EDGE OF THE 1925 DESCRIPTION AND THE SOUTHERLY EDGE OF THE 1941 DEED FROM BOOK 139 PAGE 403, A SECOND GAP OCCURS BETWEEN THE SOUTHEASTERLY EDGE OF THE 1925 DESCRIPTION AND A SMALL PARCEL DEEDED IN 1940 FROM BOOK 137 PAGE 173, THE THIRD GAP OCCURS BETWEEN THIS SAME 1940 DESCRIPTION AND THE NORTHERLY EDGE OF A 1942 DESCRIPTION (BOOK 156 PAGE 292), THIS GAP SEEMS TO BE BOUNDED ON ITS WEST SIDE BY ANOTHER 1942 DESCRIPTION (BOOK 156 PAGE 294).

OF 2900 EAST FROM DEED BOOK 137 PAGE 347, AND A SECOND PORTION COMES FROM A 1997 DESCRIPTION FOUND IN ENTRY #1473377. A GAP IN PUBLICLY OWNED TITLE IS IDENTIFIED BETWEEN THESE TWO
