RECORD DESCRIPTION:

All of Lot 19, The Summit at Ski Lake NO.4, Weber County, Utah.

SURVEYOR'S NARRATIVE

This survey was requested by Ken Nielsen to establish the boundary of Lot 19, The Summit at Ski Lake No. 4 and depict topography prerequisite to construction of a home.

This survey honors and retraces The Summit at Ski Lake No. 4 subdivision, recorded June 29, 2000, as Entry No. 1713550, Book 52, Page 47 of Official Records.

Centerline monuments found in Via Cortina Street were recovered and assigned the bearing of S 66°19'11" E as the basis of bearings to honor The Summit at Ski Lake No. 4 and The Summit at Ski Lake No. 11 subdivisions.

This Survey and Topography was performed while the site was blanketed with snow and ice. Some improved features were not visible and have been depicted from design plans.


Lot corners were recovered as noted.
